- The North Face's "Bouvet Jacket" uses 20-denier ripstop fabric with stretch knit fleece panels, filled with self-developed Ecoloft insulation
- Black Yak's "Lukla Down" features vertical tube fabric preventing fill leakage, using recycled down for eco-friendly appeal

□ Functional Design Targets Urban Lifestyle

- Discovery's "Alvert Hood Light Padding" applies graphene thermal lining for enhanced warmth and antibacterial properties
- K2's "AIRDIVE Goose Down" combines Gore Windstopper front with VIVO moisture-wicking back panel, plus graphene lining for static resistance
